We have been so impressed with the children's adventure stories—they've obviously worked very hard! We are asking the children to write them up at home, once the draft has been checked.

In English this week, we have been studying the features of play scripts and the children have had a go at converting a section of their story into a play script.

In spelling this week we looked at words which are commonly spelt incorrectly (because, hear, necessary, accommodation, friend, piece, parliament, separate) The children have thought of clever ways to remember the tricky spellings—ask them to show you what they are. There will be a small test on Monday.

In maths this week, we have continued to look at the data we collected during our Guildford shop survey. The children have investigated different ways to present their data, including using Excel to create graphs and charts. Once they had done this, they thought about what information their data had given them and about ways that this could be used. 5A and 5H looked at different types of averages and the children learnt about mean, median, mode and range (5R will be doing this next week).
