Curriculum

Some of the children have been learning a little about Anne Frank, by looking at selected excerpts from her diary. We have tried to understand a little of how she and her family may have felt.

In English this week, we have been focusing on our comprehension skills.: using different sources and wartime texts (fiction & non fiction). We concentrated on backing up our answers with evidence from the text, punctuating our work accurately and answering in full sentences.
